

- 3. Measure the distance (X). The distance (X) is the length between the bottom of adjustment nut (4) and the top of bolt (5). Record this measurement for assembly purposes. Remove nut (4) and bolt (5).
- 4. Remove the ball joint end of the tie rod. See Disassembly and Assembly, "Tie Rods (Steering) (Rear) Remove and Install".



5. Remove four bolts (6). Remove two plastic caps (7).



6. Use a suitable lifting device in order to support the housing for the steering knuckle. Use forcing screws in order to push the bearing and pin (8) out of the housing.






